

ICEME 2014– Pretask 2 – National Challenge.

Pretask 2 is a group task. Participating students from every institution are asked to solve the pretask in groups together with the participating teachers.

Deadlines:

- March 10th – Deadline for uploading documentation of the interview to Podio.
- March 24th - All groups must present the result of their pretask with a short, visual presentation for teachers and students at the IP. The presentation can be a Pecha Kucha, an elevator pitch, a short video etc. Timeframe is 15 minutes per group, time for questions included.

Step 1: Find a 'Real life challenge' at a school in your neighborhood.

Please make an appointment with a school in your neighborhood. Interview the principal or a teacher. Ask which challenge they are facing in their classroom in relation to inclusion. This can be a challenge related to everyday school life, for example:

- How do I as a teacher create a learning environment where all pupils feel like valued participants?
- Some pupils in my English class don't participate in class discussions, how do I make these pupils feel safe and interested in speaking out loud in class?

If you have received several challenges, discuss them in your group and choose one of them.

Step 2: Appointment for Skype or mail contact during the second week of the IP.

Make sure, that you can get in contact with the principal or teacher, who has given you the '*real life challenge*', during the second week of the IP: Tuesday, 25th – Thursday 27th

On Tuesday and Wednesday, you should have the possibility to ask further questions regarding the challenge and on Thursday, the principal / teacher has to provide feedback on your prototypes for solutions.

2. Send documentation of the interview to the Podio Classroom

This could be a film of the interview with subtitles or pictures and a transcript /summary of the interview.
Deadline: March 10th

3. Presentation of 'Real life Challenge' at the IP

Present your challenge with a short, visual presentation on Monday 24th. The presentation can be a Pecha Kucha, an elevator pitch, a short video etc. Timeframe is 15 minutes per group, time for questions included.
