Goals/Aims: Janneke

To make transnational balanced groups with complementary skills that can work together well

Method:

There were 7 groups with 8 cards in 4 paired colors. On the cards there were sentences that represent a certain skill and color.

Assignment:

Find 2 cards that fits you. Form groups with different colored cards, 4 students, no students of the same country.
